# Stage Information – Overall

## Access

To get on Stage there will be stairs at the side. They are anticipated Stage L.

## Times

See time schedules for load in. Breaking off is immediately after the show!  
If the appointed time for the change is over used, the time lapse will be deducted  
from the set length.

Show times include encore!

For further time information speak with Volkmar Andermann, Festival Management.

## Crowd Management

For security reason it is not allowed to invite members of the audience to get on stage during the show. The festival expects Artist's co-operation on those points.

In case of extreme emergency the head of security on stage and/or the stage manager has the authority to stop the show.  
Please inform your artist party concerning this policy.

## Sound Level

**The sound pressure level should not exceed “99dB<sub>a</sub> Leq” at any location (DIN 15905-5, November 2007, according to German Law)**

It is imperative that the maximum sound level does not exceed this limit at any time.  
Therefore the organization **keeps the right to reduce the sound level** if necessary!

## **Behavior on/off Stage**

Please note that we use high quality equipment on and off stage. This is of course sensitive and must be handled with care!

**Willful destruction of any devices is cursed with charging the Band to the amount of getting a new device like the broken one.**

Broken means a physical damaged and/or not properly working device. This is especially in reference to Microphones and Monitor Wedges.

## **Stage Information - Technical**

### **FOH and Monitor Desk**

FOH and monitor desk are shared between all bands.

For specific information see *FOH -and Monitor Tech Specs*.

An engineer from each of these departments is available to support your show.

- None of these systems are dedicated especially to one act
- We will work with one sound system
  - one (1) FOH console and processing racks (FOH position could be OFF CENTER!)
  - one (1) Monitor console and processing racks (positioned anticipated stage right)
  - one (1) pro tech Lighting desk
- **No band has the exclusive right of use of these devices**
- **Our Mixing Board is a NONE SMOKER desk!!!**
- **If a sound-tech smokes at the board, he is dropped of FOH immediately! The organization keeps the right of forcing the sound-tech not to smoke!**

### **Lights**

Please notice, that we cannot modify the light on demand.

Please be sure that we will do the best to satisfy your needs and requests.

### **Power**

Local Power is 230 Volts / 50Hz

Plugs on stage are European "Schuko", CEE 7/7 (Plug-Type E+F)

### **Backdrops**

Backdrops are hung by Stage Crew, maybe with help of band members if necessary.

If you carry backdrops, light-specials or set parts, etc., please make sure, they are corresponding to the German DIN standards.

Especially to DIN standards 4102 B1 and fire regulation (B1)!

# Special Information

## Pyro>Show Effects

In the case of using pyrotechnical effects or Show effects like spilled liquids (Water, Beer, Blood, Fake Blood etc.), please advert the technical manager to valid, at least fifteen days before the show. Festival has the authority to stop the show if security measures are not respected or technical equipment might be damaged.

With regard to pyrotechnics BLIZZARD ENTERTAINMENT would like to inform you that you all need permissions or registrations after German law, which has solely to be organized by the bands, respectively their production managers.

Upon arrival at the festival site, the permits have to be shown to the stage managers. For local production a copy of your report to German authorities is needed, as well as foreign pyrotechnics need a cover to handle, to act on German law.

## Radio Frequencies

Following frequencies are free to use in Germany without registration to local authorities: **790 - 814 MHz and 838 - 862 MHz**

Frequencies outside above mentioned range must be announced and registered to local authorities!
